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

Dr. Luc discusses in this course the advanced methods of posology of Hahnemann according to the 5th and 6th edition of the Organon. It is also called: The Split Dose Method or The Watery Solutions. The course consists of lectures, a live recorded patient example with case analysis, quiz. Read more

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Introduction & Overview

Worldwide many cases do not succeed in practice because homeopaths are only familiar with Kent's way of dosing (30, 30, 200, 200, M, M, etc.), the **“wait and watch”** method or the 4th edition Organon method. Homeopaths also know very little about the correct use of the LM potencies (also called Q potencies). Many cases fail (even on the correct remedy) because homeopaths do not use Hahnemann's advanced methods of dosing. The solution often lies in carefully applying the watery solution of the 5th or 6th Organon editions. Most of the time you need much more gentle dosing, infrequently given and individually adapted to the reaction of the patient.

This course consists of video lectures, optional quiz questions and a few final (optional) assignments in the course summary document. Some lectures are partly overlapping, but are also complementary to each other. Because it is so important to apply posology correctly in practice, it is beneficial to repeat a few things.

Dr. Luc says: Applying Hahnemann's advanced posology methods will greatly increase your results in practice. It is very unfortunate that only a few homeopathic colleges spend time on it.

This course discusses Hahnemann's advanced methods of posology according to the 5th and 6th edition of the Organon. This kind of posology is also known as *The Split Dose Method* or *The Watery Solutions*.

- The course includes an example of Dr. Luc's systematic approach to case analysis (a live recorded case with case analysis).
- The course consists of approximately 12 hours of video lectures.
- There are optional quiz questions after each course section.
- At the end of the course, at your request, you will receive a final document with some additional information and a few optional assignments.
- Throughout the course you can ask your personal course moderator for assistance. You may ask questions asked about the course content after you have completed each section.

This course is aimed at

- All students of homeopathy who are already familiar with the main principles of homeopathy and who are familiar the Kentian method of dosing.
- All working homeopaths who have not been taught about the changes which Hahnemann introduced during the later years of his life, when he wrote the 5th and 6th editions of the Organon.

Course topic

In homeopathy there is worldwide a big misunderstanding about “the dose”.

Many schools still teach that the only important issue is to find the simillimum remedy, and that the dose does not matter: *Just give 1, 2 or 3 granules dry, then 'wait and watch'*.

Contrary to this belief Hahnemann found out that it is not only the right remedy that matters, but also:

- The right Potency
- The right Frequency
- The right Amount

A live-recorded case offers a practical example of Dr. Luc's systematic case analysis and includes the case evaluation at a follow-up. The example case shows one of the common errors that can happen regarding posology.

This case offers an introduction to Dr. Luc's systematic approach to case analysis.

General learning objectives of this course in advanced posology

At the end of this course participants should have learned the following:

- Have an overview of the changes Hahnemann made regarding posology.
- Know how the advanced posology of the 5th and 6th edition of the Organon should be applied in acute and chronic cases and also when using nosodes.
- Know how to adapt the posology during follow-up visits according to the 5th and 6th edition of the Organon.
- Know how to apply the 'teaspoon method'.
- Know how to apply the 'drop method'.
- Gain experience with case management through real case example exercises.
- Know which efficient questions to ask during the follow-up visit to better evaluate the reaction of the patient, e.g. be familiar with "the follow-up questions".
- A real live-recorded case and case analysis will allow participants to gain experience in a particular approach to general case analysis using systematic steps.
- A real live case follow-up will show a real situation of errors in posology and how to correct this.
- A real live case will allow the participants to learn a certain important polychrest remedy in depth.

Course lectures - content summary

Total duration of all video lectures: 11h 55min.

Summary of the topics Dr. Luc discusses during this course:

Advanced Posology Part 1: Introduction to the 4th, 5th, 6th Organon edition

The course starts with a short introduction that explains briefly how Hahnemann's thinking developed over time and also focuses especially on the major changes of the 4th edition of the Organon, going to the 5th and then leading to the 6th edition of the Organon.

Advanced Posology Part 2: Potency selection (acute + chronic) & Cyber Delusion (core delusion) Lycopodium

During the first seminar in Hechtel, Belgium (2011), Luc gave a summary of potency selection and dosing (posology) for chronic and acute cases. Luc also answers several questions from participants. Included is the Core Delusion of Lycopodium.

Advanced Posology Part 3: Potency selection and second prescription (2012 Hechtel) + remedy relationships

This lecture gives a comprehensive overview of the last years of Hahnemann's development in dosing (posology). Dr. Luc explains how to use and achieve the benefits of the 5th and 6th edition method of dosing.

Advanced Posology Part 4: Exercises potency selection

The previous theory is illustrated with clear case examples. A great lecture with many answers and questions from the audience!

Advanced Posology Part 5: Follow-up questions for patient evaluation

Worldwide, most things that go wrong in the homeopathic practice happen during the patient evaluation and particularly at the second and further follow-up consultations, called *management of the patient*. In this lecture Dr. Luc discusses what you need to check carefully (guidelines) with your patient so that you can evaluate the response correctly. These guidelines are also given to the patient at the first consultation.

Advanced Posology Part 6: Example live-recorded case with follow-up overview

This patient is a great example of a certain remedy. Luc analyses the case step-by-step following the “**Case Analysis Questions**”.

You will also see how the “**Core Delusion**” method is built on top of a normal, full case analysis. The case also illustrates well how Dr. Luc uses the ‘**extended meaning**’ of repertory rubrics.

Advanced Posology Part 7: Potency selection and second prescription (2012 Netherlands)

In this lecture a comprehensive overview is given of the last years of Hahnemann's development in dosing (posology). Dr. Luc explains how to use and achieve the benefits of the 5th and 6th edition method of dosing.

With this lecture you will have a clear summary of the previously discussed topic of posology.

Advanced Posology Part 7 C: Course summary & assignments & certificate

Basic knowledge needed

This course in advanced posology expects that you are already familiar with the fundamental principles of homeopathy, e.g. the simillimum principle, primary and secondary action (Organon § 64-66), regarding the minimal dose and the 4th edition (Kentian) method of dosing (you can read the appropriate chapters in Kent's *Lectures on Philosophy*). This course focuses on the more advanced 5th and 6th edition posology, the watery solutions method that Hahnemann applied in his later years.

Duration 3 months (can extended if needed)

You have 3 months viewing time to complete the whole course. Time needed
